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General Commentary:

- Project dissertation
 - As paper 5 is a key aspect of becoming a Master Brewer or a Master Distiller the content and quality of the project undertaken must reflect the advanced level of this qualification
 - It is vitally important that candidates are clear in their submission as to the role that they undertook in the project and also provide evidence of this
 - Candidates need to show a clear application of knowledge, as well as significant experiential knowledge in the work they submit.
 - General comments
 - It is key that candidates read the instructions provided on the presentation and layout of their final document paying attention to the following:
 - Final project must be neat, have clear, defined sections and be professional
 - This includes areas such as Table of Context, References, Appendices etc
 - Clear evidence gathering as well as appropriate analysis of results should be presented.
 - Candidates must also pay close attention to the word count. At this level, being able to provide detailed, yet concise data and analysis is part of the skills required for a successful project submission.
- Time Management
 - Candidates are reminded that this project submission is the final part of the qualification and therefore a suitable amount of time must be spent on the project documentation as well as the application of the project matter.
- Application of Knowledge
 - At Masters level, candidates are expected to have experience in at least mid to senior roles within the industry. Candidates are therefore expected to be able to demonstrate the application of their wider knowledge and experience to the project submission.
